The Colville Rotary Club partnered with the HUB financially and with volunteers to deliver meals. Then the HUB received a \$6000.00 grant from the Innovia Foundation. The Flower Basket fundraiser was a success, despite the Covid quarantine, the Wynne Street construction and the spring rain. The HUB even received 5 new memberships during the quarantine. Our doors may be closed but we are still doing business!

We all know that the quarantine has created economic pressures for everyone. Nonprofits, like the HUB, are no different. There are many rumors stating that the HUB is going bankrupt or we are having to sell the building but they are just rumors. The bank account is lower than we like but the bills are being paid and lunches are being made, despite the inordinate increase in food costs. The forms have been filed for a second grant from the Innovia Foundation. The intention of the remaining 2019-2020 Board of Directors is to keep the HUB open for business and to be fiscally sound. The nominees for the 2020-2021 Board also agree that is what we will do.

Please take the time to read all the information provided about the upcoming elections in June. Because of the Quarantine, we have chosen to use mail in ballots. It is **VERY** important that each of our members votes for the new Board members and the proposed changes to membership fees. Voting is your right. Voting is your way of keeping the HUB open and working.

This will be my last message to you from me as the President of the HUB. My husband is declining and I want this time to spoil him. Your new Board will give you new ideas and leadership for the HUB. Annual Elections

June 12, 2020 is the date for this year's annual elections. Traditionally, members of the HUB would come to the meeting and vote but because of the Covid quarantine we will use mail in ballots this year. There will be two items to vote on. First is the election of the new Board of Directors. We will list the volunteers and the position they are running for. You are to check yes or no.

The second item to be voted on is the increase in membership fees. Membership fees have not increased since the HUB opened 5 years ago. We all know that electricity and the cost of food has increased dramatically during that 5-year period. The Board is proposing a small increase of just \$5.00. That means that an individual membership will go from \$20.00 a year to \$25.00 a year and that the cost of a couple will increase from \$35.00 to \$ 45.00; if this is approved by the membership. **Your vote counts!**
